



By car:

Access via motorway A7 or A55, exit : Vieux-Port, follow the signs *Pharo/Les Plages*
Paying indoor car park situated in the Boulevard Charles Livon, in the opposite.

By plane:

Marseille-Provence airport is 25 km far :

Taxis (about 50 euros) or shuttles are available at the train station Gare Saint Charles.

By bus:

Shuttle bus run from the airport to the train station Gare St-Charles (situated in the city centre) every 20 minutes between 6.10 am and 10.50 pm.

After 10.50 pm shuttles depend on arrival flights.

Ticket: 8.50 € a single ticket

Journey lasts about 25 minutes

To go from the Gare Saint Charles to the Vieux-Port (about 1.5 km)

You can take the underground (2 stations), follow *La Timone* (line 1) and get off at the *Vieux-Port* station.

By taxi:

Day charges: 37€; Night charges: 46€

Journey lasts about 25 minutes

By train:

The train or the « TGV » arrives at the Gare Saint Charles right in the city centre (1.5km from the Vieux-Port). Take the underground: line 1, follow *La Timone* and stop at the *Vieux-Port* station; then take the bus: lines 83 or 81. Bus N0 83 runs from the Vieux-Port and the Pharo every 10-15 minutes; it departs near the *Vieux-Port* station (from the seaside) and stops just in front of the Pharo- *Le Pharo* station (journey lasts about 3 minutes).

It is a 10/15-minute walk from the Vieux-Port to the Pharo if you walk along the quay.
